RE: AMENDMENTS TO COURT OF QUEEN'S BENCH RULES

The following amendments will come into force on
December 1, 2011:

1. Subrule 16.02(1)(g)

This subrule has been amended to correct the reference to section 14 of *The Proceedings Against the Crown Act* to section 11 of *The Proceedings Against the Crown Act*.

2. Rule 59.07 - Failure to Provide Notice of Satisfaction

This rule has been amended to add subrules 59.07(3) and 59.07(4). These new subrules provide that a judge may, on motion, grant an order declaring that an earlier order of the court has been satisfied. To obtain such an order, the moving party must establish that the earlier order has been satisfied and that the party in whose favour the earlier order was granted cannot be located or is unwilling to sign a notice of satisfaction.

3. Form 66A - Judgment for Partition or Sale

This form has been amended to comply with subrules 54.04(1)(a)(ii) and (iii). Specifically, clauses have been added to designate which party has conduct of the sale, and to order that, if the land is sold, title vest in the name of the purchaser named in the Report and Order on Sale.

4. Form 72K - Reconciliation and Closing Inventory

This form has been amended to include only one column headed "Amount" in connection with the Reconciliation, and one column headed "Closing date value" in connection with the Closing Inventory.
