

**NOTICE  
PROVINCIAL COURT OF MANITOBA**

**RE: Case Management Conference Coordinator's Docket**

Commencing October 31, 2011, the following changes will come into effect in regard to the Case Management process:

1. Preliminary Hearing and Trial Dates will now be set in chambers with the assistance of the Case Management Coordinator or in the Trial Coordinator's Office immediately following the Case Management Conference.
2. Where a matter appears on the Case Management Docket for the purpose of setting a Case Management Conference or Hearing date and a date has not been confirmed by the fourth appearance on the Case Management Docket, a Case Management Conference date will be set by the Case Management Coordinator and counsel are expected to attend on the date set.
3. Lengthy remands on the Case Management docket will be permitted provided the remand is approved by the Case Management Judge. However the matter must appear on the Case Management Docket two weeks after the Case Management conference prior to the lengthy remand.
