The purpose of this notice is to advise counsel that when they are filing a Notice of Garnishment by general creditor (Section 4 of *The Garnishment Act*) it must be accompanied by a Garnishee's Statement (Form 60G). Recently, many Notices of Garnishment by general creditor (Section 4 of *The Garnishment Act*) have been accompanied with an incorrect Garnishee's Statement(s), specifically Form 60G.1 and Form 60G.1.1.

The Registry must be provided with all proper documentation and accompanying fees or the documentation will be rejected and returned to counsel.
