THE HONOURABLE JUSTICE MARC M. MONNIN

Justice Marc Monnin was appointed to the Manitoba Court of Appeal on February 3, 2011. Prior to that time, he served as Chief Justice of the Manitoba Court of Queen's Bench from March 2003, having been appointed as a judge of the Court of Queen's Bench on August 28, 1997. While Chief Justice, he was a member of the Canadian Judicial Council where he served on several committees including as a vice-chair of the Judicial Conduct Committee and chair of the Committee on Self-Represented Litigants. He received his BA from Collège de Saint Boniface in 1973 and his LLB from l'Université du Manitoba in 1977. He was called to the Manitoba Bar in 1978. Before his appointment to the bench, Justice Monnin practised law with the firm of Aikins MacAulay & Thorvaldson in Winnipeg. His areas of practice were civil litigation, transportation law, administrative law and employment law. He was twice elected bencher of the Law Society of Manitoba and served as chair of the Competence, Discipline and Education Committees.
