PROVINCIAL COURT OF MANITOBA (WINNIPEG CENTRE)

RE: Seniority of Counsel in Video Courtroom

To ensure the effective use of video conferencing for court, the court clerk must provide the correctional centres linking in to the video courtroom with a list of accused from that centre who will be appearing that day. The list must be sent to the correctional centres 15 minutes prior to court commencing.

Counsel should attend the courtroom by 9:45 a.m. to advise the clerk that he or she has a client scheduled to appear that day. The clerk will create the list based on the seniority of those counsel who have attended the court by 9:45 a.m.

Once court opens, matters will be called according to the list. Any request to change the order on the list must be made to the presiding judge.
