**RE: ADJUSTMENT TO CURRENT SCHEDULING PROTOCOLS -  
FEBRUARY 1 TO 26, 2021**

This is to advise that the adjustments to the Court's scheduling practices for Family Division Proceedings as announced in the December 3, 2020 Practice Direction will now also extend and apply to the period of February 1 to 26, 2021.

All currently-scheduled Family and Child Protection trials set to proceed between Monday, February 1 and Friday, February 26, 2021, where **all** parties are **not** represented by counsel, will be adjourned to an administrative list for rescheduling on **Friday, February 26, 2021**.

All currently-scheduled Family and Child Protection trials set to proceed between Monday, February 1 and Friday, February 26, 2021, where all parties are represented by counsel, will continue presumptively to be heard via video conference in accordance with the Practice Direction issued December 3, 2020.

All other judicial services currently being offered by the Court of Queen's Bench Family Division by video or audio conference will continue as before, unchanged.
