COURT OF APPEAL

RE: CRIMINAL JUDGMENTS

There is a revised procedure with respect to the release of criminal reserved judgments.

1. Where an accused is in custody, the reasons for judgment will be released in the ordinary manner; i.e., counsel will be advised that the reasons will be available to be picked up on a particular day.
2. Where an accused is **not** in custody and where there is a possibility of incarceration, seven to ten days' notice will be given by the court to the accused and to Crown and defence counsel to report to Court of Appeal Chambers Courtroom 130 at 9:30 a.m., usually on a Thursday, for the release of the reasons for judgment.

This notice replaces the notice of November 8, 2005.
