

NOTICE OF PRACTICE DIRECTION

MANITOBA COURT OF APPEAL

RE: SECURITY FOR COSTS REQUIRED ON MOTIONS REQUESTING A REHEARING

Effective November 17, 2025, an amendment was made to rule 46.2 of the MB, *Court of Appeal Rules (Civil)*, Man Reg 555/88R, which governs motions to request a rehearing. The amendment requires a party filing a motion requesting a rehearing to pay \$500 into Court as security for costs at the time the motion is filed.

The posting of security for costs is mandatory; a motion for a rehearing will not be accepted by the Registry without payment of the security for costs in full into Court at the time the motion is filed. The security for costs posted will be held by the Court until the motion for a rehearing is disposed of and then dealt with in accordance with any order of the Court as to costs.
