Submitting Court Orders for Signature

Orders submitted for endorsement in the Court of Queen's Bench should be filed with the

Queen's Bench Registry Officers to ensure that the order is signed and processed as

quickly as possible. Orders that are directly mailed or delivered to the Judge's Chambers

are not properly processed and tracked on the computerized Registry system and can

result in signed orders being misplaced or distribution of copies being delayed. Counsel

are strongly encouraged not to mail or deliver orders directly to Judges Chambers, except

when otherwise directed by the Judge.

Release of Queen's Bench Files

In situations where counsel require a file be released to them such as to attend before a

Stand-By Judge or to process an order signed in court, the Motions Coordination staff or

Court Clerk will complete an Authorization to Release Oueen's Bench File form to which

counsel's undertaking is attached. Your compliance with these procedures will help to

improve document/file management practices in the Court and enable us to provide a

higher level of service delivery to clients.
