Effective Monday, January 23, 2017, in Winnipeg Centre only, any application to the Court of Queen's Bench for judicial review shall be filed electronically. Paper or manual applications will not be accepted.

An E-Filing Technical Directions Bulletin can be found on the Court's website. It specifies the process and requirements for e-filing.

For further clarity, the nature of judicial reviews subject to this Practice Direction will include those contemplated by Queen's Bench Rule 68 and other appeals or reviews on record from administrative tribunals. These would include, for example, review of labour arbitration awards and other appeals or reviews on record as contemplated in various statutes.
