VARIATION OF A PROBATION ORDER

INFORMATION SHEET

An application to vary a probation order is required where a person has been granted probation and seeks to change the terms of the probation order. The crown attorney or a probation officer can also make an application to vary a probation order. Follow the steps below for making an application:

- Obtain an “Application to Vary a Probation Order” form from any court office or probation office.
- Complete part 1 of the application and attach a copy of your probation order.
- For Individuals on Supervised Probation Orders: Give the completed form to your probation officer/case manager so they can complete part 2. Your probation officer/case manager will then forward the application to the crown attorney to complete part 3.
- For Individuals with Unsupervised Probation Orders: Give the completed application to the crown attorney's office so they can complete part 3.
- If the Crown is **not opposed** to the change, the application will be forwarded to the court office for the judge's consideration. If the judge approves the change you will be notified in writing.
- If the Crown is **opposed** to the change or if the judge will not approve the change without a court hearing you will be notified in writing. You will be provided with information explaining how a hearing can be arranged should you wish to continue with your application.
