RE: MASK USE AND COURT REOPENING

On February 25th, the Manitoba Courts outlined a transition plan for the gradual easing of COVID-19 related restrictions in court facilities.

A reminder that mask use will no longer be required in court facilities effective **Monday, May 16, 2022**. Masks may continue to be worn, unless requested otherwise by a presiding judge in the context of a hearing.

Unlimited access to the courts by members of the public will resume on **Monday, June 27th**, at which time there will no longer be any COVID-19 related restrictions in place.

We continue to ask all court users to demonstrate courtesy and respect for others, including not attending court facilities when sick.

As always, the Manitoba Courts will continue to monitor the public health situation and make adjustments as required.
