

**NOTICE**  
**COURT OF QUEEN'S BENCH OF MANITOBA**

**RE: NO NEED TO SELF-ISOLATE FOR OUT-OF-PROVINCE  
PARTIES OR WITNESSES**

This will confirm that the requirement announced in the Notice of February 4, 2021, as refined in the Notice of October 20, 2021, that all parties or witnesses who wish to attend in person for their proceedings in the Court of Queen's Bench and who are coming from outside of Manitoba are required to self-isolate for 14 days, no longer applies to persons who are not displaying symptoms of COVID-19.

The most recent and previously released Notices and Practice Directions remain unchanged and should be consulted in relation to presumptions and directions governing in-person and virtual hearings.
